Roots of Music Program (RoMP)

A weekly, semester-long program that explores rhythm, melody, and dynamics through the music and cultures of West Africa, the U.S., and Mexico. Includes in-school lessons, three live concerts, and a student performance.

RoMP on the Road

This mobile version of RoMP brings all the learning and fun directly to your school—ideal for campuses located farther from the Grand Annex.



Recorders in Schools

A full-year program with 24 weekly classes in recorder playing technique, music notation, and ensemble performance. Teachers receive resources to link lessons with history, math, and culture.

The Percussion Program

Offered as a semester or year-long program, students explore call-and-response, polyrhythms, and creative percussion performance inspired by global traditions. STEAM and history connections deepen student understanding.

Strings in Schools: Violins

Students build foundational musicianship and violin skills 24 weekly group classes per year. This hands-on program strengthens focus, discipline, and teamwork.

Taste of RoMP

A condensed, 3-week version of our Roots of Music Program. Includes classroom lessons and a live concert field trip—perfect for schools seeking a short-term but impactful experience.

CAP/ELOP Concerts

Live concerts that meet Cultural Arts Passport (CAP) and Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELOP) guidelines. Held at the Grand Annex or your school, these performances expose students to dynamic, professional musicians.

Music Shop Masterclass

In one day, students learn and perform customized arrangements with professional musicians. Includes a masterclass, rehearsals, a sound check and final concert.

The Sound of STEAM

A project-based after-school program where 4th-6th graders build musical instruments while learning core science and math concepts. Accessible for all learners, aligned with NGSS and UDL principles, and culminating in a student performance.

Literacy Support Through Music

This family-friendly workshop equips parents and families with music-infused reading strategies to boost literacy at home. Aligned with K-5 CA ELD Standards - no musical experience required!
